The REDD- Web Platform, mandated by the COP in decision 2/CD-23, was established with the purpose of making available such information on the outcomes of activities relating to REDD-, including activities on capacity building, demonstration activities, addressing drivers of deforestation and mobilization of resources.

Since the launch of the REDD+ Web Platform after COP 13, both the COP and the Subsidiary Body for Scientific and Retendencel Advice (SBSTA) have recognized the Platform as a useful tool and inave mandated additional functions to be
