Overview of Ecuador's Programme Proposal to GCF: Key Features



- Phase 2 proposal: Up-front investments to implement REDD+ Action Placificent nations.
- National scale
- Fully aligned with UNFCCC decisions & processes
- Inter-sectoral / multi-level



- Strong alignment with national policies
 - **Ministry of Agriculture**: Agenda for the transformation of agricultural production in the Amazon
 - Ministry of Foreign Trade: "Marca Pais" country brand initiative
 - National land use planning policy implemented by local governments
- Financing: Significant co-finance, and alignment of all international support towards a single National REDD+ Action Plan

Key Lessons from Ecuador

Very demanding proposal requirements

→ Outputs from REDD+ Readiness are critical for proposal development process: (National Strategy, FREL, NFMS, SIS)

- ✓ **Drivers analysis:** include market overview
- ✓ Consultations documented clearly
- ✓ Policies and measures (PAMs): supported by detailed economic & financial analysis
- ✓ **SIS**: aligned with GCF requirements
- Very demanding review process: Secretariat review followed by TAP review
 → Dedicated staff required
- Unclear linkages between Phase 2 (Investments) and Phase 3 (RBPs) of REDD+ under the GCF: grants for investment discounted from future RBPs?
 → Have a detailed understanding of UNFCCC requirements and a clear long term vision for your country
