#### **Introductory Notes**

The Funding Framework is periodically submitted to the Policy Board of the UN-REDD Programme Fund by the Executive Coordinator of the Multi-Partner Trust Fund Office. Table 1 provides information on fund availability as required by the Policy Board for approval of new joint programmes. The document also presents more detailed information on contributions received, amounts transferred to Participating UN Organizations and amounts approved for distribution to a Participating Organization but pending transfer.

#### **Table 1: Fund Status**

This table highlights: (a) total funds received by the MPTF Office as Administrative Agent; (b) funds transferred to Participating UN Organizations less any refunds; and (c) the current fund balance, which is allocated between (i) funds that have already been approved and are programmed but not yet transferred to a Participating UN Organization; and (ii) funds remaining to be programmed. These figures [(a) through (c)] have been further segregated into amounts earmarked or un-earmarked by donors.
