1. Background Information on Ecuador

- Deforestation rate amongst highest in South America
- Yearly almost 200.000 hectares are lost (1,46%) / 55 million tons
- 10 million hectares of native forest still to protect
- To change this trend...
 - Constitution (2008)
 - National Development Plan (2009 – 2013)

Results of the UNREDD mission in Ecuador

- Jointly Conducted: Government of Ecuador UNREDD Programme – German Cooperation (KfW – GTZ)
- <u>Mission Objective</u>: Jointly define with the Government of Ecuador initial ideas of the future contribution of the UNREDD Programme for Ecuador's Readiness Phase
- <u>Mission Results</u>: Draft-Detailed log-frame based on the needs previously identified by the Government for the readiness phase (in coordination with the German cooperation programme)
- This log-frame has six results

MRV	To engage as much as possible in the field data collection to local community members	IPs (Sucumbios Workshop)
MRV	Deliver the results of the NFI to community members	IPs (Sucumbios Worshop)
Engagement	Create a platform for dialogue and conflict-management between grassroots and indigenous organizations and between communities	IPs (Tena Workshop)
Engagement	Create audio and visual material for dissemination of REDD+ information	IPs (Tena Workshop)
Policies & Measures	CSOs and IPs should participate on the definition of policies	CSOS (Quito Workshop)
Operational Framework	The national registration system should include verification from MAE in the field to ensure communities are informed and agree with the development of REDD+ projects/initiatives	IPs (Sucumbios Workshop)
Multiple Benefits	Communities should participate in the implementation of the monitoring system	IPs (Tena Workshop)
Benefit Sharing	A third party should manage the benefit sharing mechanism	IPs (Sucumbios Workshop)

4. Ecuador 's roadmap to March 2011: Proposal for the UN REDD PB

- <u>Ongoing activities</u>: On many of the components identified for the National REED+ Strategy
- <u>Strong commitment from Government</u>: National funds invested (almost 10 million already invested and more coming up) & provisions on policies
- <u>Active in the international discussions</u>: UNFCCC and other arenas
- <u>Observer for too long</u>: Informally since PB 1 and officially since PB3
- <u>Resources Needed</u>: Some activities are not fully covered (JPD almost ready)

The request of Ecuador for the PB on its 5th session is:

 To <u>earmark funds</u> for Ecuador s NJP (USD 5,04 million) UN-REDD P R O G R A M M E
