Question 1: opportunities for early use, joint application

- Training
- Piloting: workshops (fdg, ip) to test and check what's lacking and how to link with rights, how to make locally usable, deep dialogue needed
- REDD+ countries, Framework in any country
- Right context for application (REDD+ RPP, VPA, development investments, forest governance learning groups)

Question 1: opportunities for early use, joint application

- Country decision: local demand must exist, not our testing but can be promoted by organizations behind initiatives
- Projects (resource needs and constraints to be considered, manageable -> phased)
- Cross sectoral participation requires adaptation
- Consensus seeking dialogue processes
- Joint application: who would facilitate, requirements different
- Are products parallel or sequential?

Question 2: support

- Make simpler: prepare a joint summary note (e.g. based on Eva's presentation, cross references)
- Support local ownership, language editions
- Remain flexible, adaptable: this is a menu -> ownership
- Promotional material to people involved, adapt to audience (incl. high level)
- Information/endorsement from high-level champions (President)
- TA, money, but from where? (clear if linked to projects or programs), local funding/cost sharing supports ownership

Question 3: sharing lessons learnt

- Global contact/focal point for collecting, sharing lessons
 - organization, network, open wg
 - can be also national, regional coordination
 - ensure feedback
 - what is the process of selection, depends on who will use
- Results available (e.g. online)
- Establish best international practice (e.g. formal publication), evolution over time
- National dissemination
- Tools for best practice to show inclusive national implementation, change over time

Question 4: productive and practical use

- See above
- Genuine demand from countries
- Finding right entry points
- Must be based on serious internal dialogue
- Requires testing
- Using for capacity building/training or visible side events
