About

Overview

The United Nations Collaborative Programme on Reducing Emissions from Deforestation and Forest Degradation in Developing Countries (UN-REDD Programme) is a collaboration between FAO, UNDP and UNEP. A multi-donor trust fund was established in July 2008 that allows donors to pool resources and provides funding to activities towards this programme.

The Intergovernmental Panel on Climate Change (IPCC) estimates that the cutting down of forests is now contributing close to 20 per cent of the overall greenhouse gases entering the atmosphere. Forest degradation also makes a significant contribution to emissions from forest ecosystems. Therefore there is an immediate need to make significant progress in reducing deforestation, forest degradation, and associated emission of greenhouse gases.

The United Nations Framework Convention on Climate Change (UNFCCC) agenda item on "Reducing emissions from deforestation in developing countries and approaches to stimulate action" was first introduced at the Conference of the Parties (COP11) in December 2005 by the governments of Papua New Guinea and Costa Rica, supported by eight other Parties. The challenge was to establish a functioning international REDD finance mechanism that can be included in an agreed post-2012 global climate change framework. Progress has been made and the need to meet the challenge is now reflected in the Bali Action Plan and the COP13 Decision 2/CP.13. A functioning international REDD finance mechanism needs to be able to provide the appropriate revenue streams to the right people at the right time to make it worthwhile for them to change their forest resource use behaviour.

In response to the COP13 decision, requests from countries, and encouragement from donors, FAO, UNDP and UNEP have developed a collaborative REDD programme. The UN-REDD Programme is aimed at tipping the economic balance in favour of sustainable management of forests so that their formidable economic

About

The UNFCCC conference in Bali recognized Viet Nam as one of the top five most affected countries in the world as a result of climate change. Viet Nam is one of nine countries identified for country programming under UN-REDD programme and was also one of the first countries to receive approval for an R-PIN under the World Bank's Forest Carbon Partnership Facility (FCPF).

Although not suffering from excessive levels of deforestation typical of some other countries in the region, deforestation is locally significant in Viet Nam, especially in the Central Highlands. Furthermore, the quality of natural forests continues to be more fragmented and degraded. Over two-thirds of Viet Nam's natural forests are considered poor or regenerating, while rich and closed-canopy forest constitutes only 4.6 percent (in 2004) of the total.

Fast economic growth within the country and the drive to export commodities is an underlying driver of change within Viet Nam. There are growing efforts by the authorities to combat these problems but the pressures are intensifying. If the

The UN-REDD Programme for Viet Nam seeks to address deforestation and forest gradation through capacity building at national and local levels. Firstly, it will ild capacity at the national level to permit the Government of Viet Nam, and pecially the REDD focal point in the Department of Forestry (DoF) of the nistry of Agriculture and Rural Development (MARD), to coordinate and manage e process of establishing tools to implement a REDD programme. Secondly, it Il build capacity at local levels (provincial, district and commune) through pilots two districts in Lam Dong province that demonstrate effective approaches to anning and implementing measures to reduce emissions.

e Objective of the UN-REDD Viet Nam Programme is "To assist the Government Viet Nam in developing an effective REDD regime in Viet Nam and to contribute reduction of regional leakage." This will contribute to the broader Goal of suring that "By the end of 2012 Viet Nam is REDD-ready and able to contribute reducing emissions from deforestation and forest degradation nationally and gionally."
