From Copenhagen to Cancún

- **Copenhagen Accord & reference to REDD**
- **US\$ 3.5 billion pledged for REDD+**
- **Requests for stronger collaboration among the REDD+ initiatives**
- **Global interim REDD+ partnership arrangement**

KEY POINTS:

- **UN-REDD Programme has been growing**
- **Programme has increased its support at the country level**
- **Programme continued to seek closer partnerships with other REDD+ actors**



UN-REDD Strategy

- Held two strategic planning meetings
- Developed instrument for soliciting stakeholder inputs
- Started process of getting inputs from partners
- Prepared draft strategy elements for this Policy Board

KEY DECISION:

- Endorsement of strategy elements and guidance on the future work
- Guidance on partnerships especially how we should collaborate with FCPF




Funding Pledges

- Programme has received new funding pledges

KEY DECISION:

Policy Board to formally note pledges

8 new countries – increasing demand





National Programmes

- **Progress in National Programme design:**
 - **The formulation of REDD+ Readiness “Roadmaps”**
 - **Engagement of Stakeholders**
 - **Designing Carbon Monitoring Systems**
 - **Strengthening national inventories**



National Programmes

- **DRC signed a decree for REDD+**
- **Benefit Distribution Study completed in Viet Nam**
- **Validation meetings in Bolivia, DRC and Zambia**
- **Tanzania and Indonesia officially signed and submitted final National Programme Documents**
- **Official launch of UN-REDD National Programme in Tanzania**



Global Programme: MRV

- **Systematic review of existing evidence on methods to measure and assess terrestrial C stocks and their changes.**
- **UN-REDD liaising with new partners:**
 - **Google**
 - **GEO**
 - **INPE (Brazil Space Agency)**



Global Programme: Governance - IP/CSO

- **UN-REDD Programme presented and engaged with IP/CSO stakeholders at a variety of meetings globally and nationally**
- **Further progress on FPIC, recourse, and harmonization with FPCF**
- **Supporting establishment of national systems that facilitate participation of all stakeholders in all phases of REDD+ design, implementation and monitoring**



Multiple Benefits

- **Consultations in Bolivia, Indonesia, Viet Nam and Tanzania on how to define and promote REDD+ co-benefits**



Collaboration with FCPF

- **Joint letter by the UN Secretary-General and President of World Bank**
- **Consultations with FCPF have continued and strengthened**

KEY DECISION:

Proposals on concrete ways to reduce transaction costs and increase efficiency of supporting REDD+ countries
