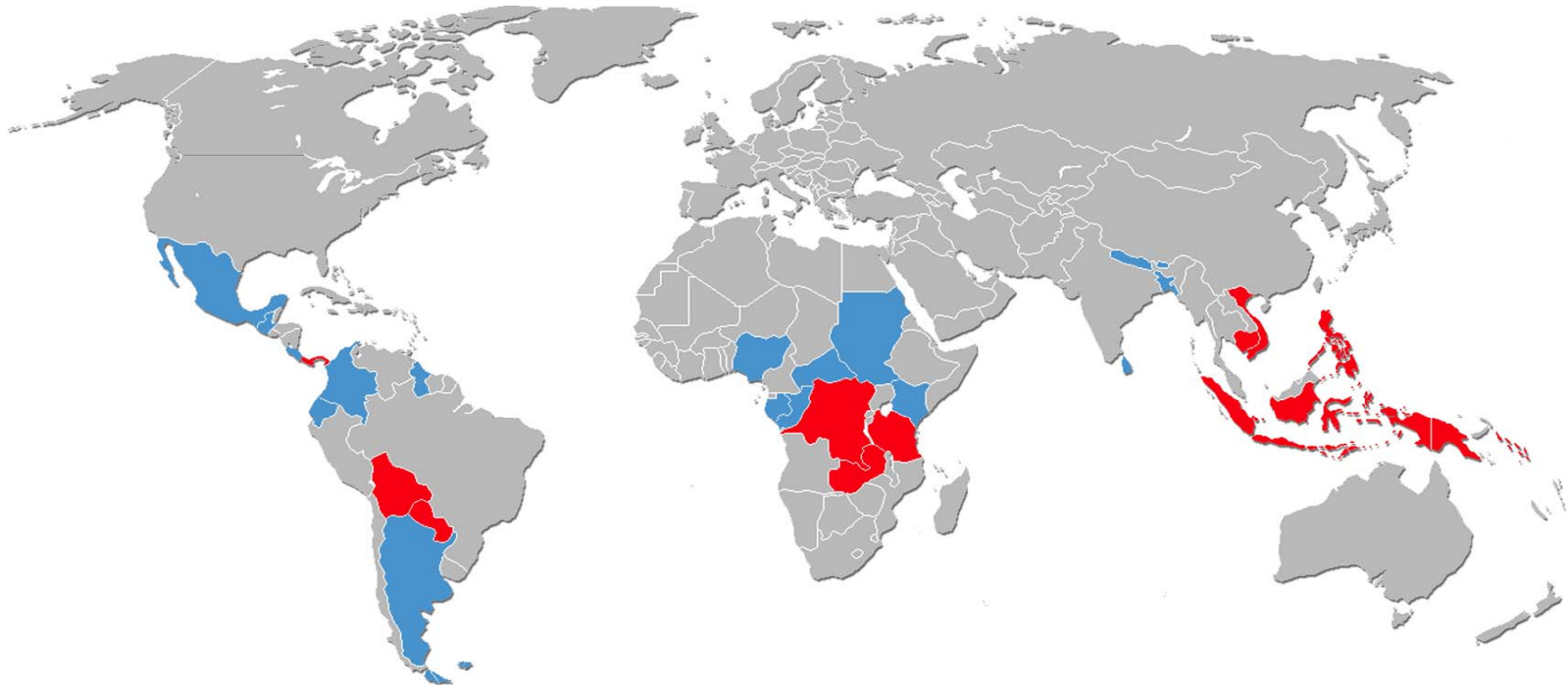


UN-REDD Programme Highlights

- Three new National Programmes (NPs) moved into their implementation phase, total is now 7
- *Ecuador* completed preparation of their National Programme Document
- Draft Global Programme Framework Document developed
- TOR for Internal Review of the Programme approved
- New requests from countries to join Programme
- 2010 Year in Review launched
- Strong UN-REDD presence at the COP16 in Cancun, Mexico
- Missions to several countries
- Growing donor base



UN-REDD Partner Countries



- Countries receiving support to National Programmes:** Bolivia, Cambodia, Democratic Republic of Congo (DRC), Indonesia, Panama, Papua New Guinea, Paraguay, Solomon Islands, the Philippines, United Republic of Tanzania, Viet Nam, Zambia
- Other partner countries:** Argentina, Bangladesh, Bhutan, Central African Republic, Colombia, Costa Rica, Ecuador, Gabon, Guatemala, Guyana, Kenya, Mexico, Nepal, Nigeria, Republic of Congo, Sri Lanka, Sudan

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National Programmes

- Since PB5, 3 new countries have moved to the implementation phase: *Bolivia, Panama and Zambia*
- Examples of progress in implementation include:
 - *DRC*: A REDD+ national registry launched
 - *Indonesia*: Draft National REDD+ Strategy concluded
 - *Tanzania* : Key coordination arrangements in place
 - *Viet Nam*: REDD+ Benefit Distribution System developed based on consultations at the local level
- *Cambodia, Philippines, Solomon Islands, PNG and Paraguay* are in the process of finalizing their NP Documents



National Programmes

- ***Ecuador*** will present its National Programme Document for funding request at this meeting
- ***Nigeria*** completed preparation of their National Programme
- Various tools for improving National Programme design, implementation and monitoring are under development (harmonized template, NP guidelines, and monitoring and evaluation framework)
- Working Group on criteria for prioritization of funding allocations for new National Programmes concluded its work and will present the proposal tomorrow



Global Programme

- **Training of technical and IT persons on MRV& Monitoring, including GHG emissions reporting supported in collaboration with INPE**
- **Dialogue on-going on “monitoring” safeguards**
- **Global guidelines being developed and tested for Free, Prior, and Informed Consent (FPIC)**
- **Social and environmental standards and risk assessment tool being developed**
- **Draft 5-yr GP framework developed, for consideration by the Board**
