

## Request for Policy Board Inter-Sessional Decision February 23, 2010

*Responding* to the representative of the Government of Norway's request that a decision be taken by the Policy Board by 3 March 2010, in reference to a decision by the Sub Committee of the Forest Investment Programme to "request the Climate Investment Funds Administrative Unit to work with other multilateral REDD+ institutions and REDD+ initiatives to study options for enhancing cooperation and for seeking coherence among them to support countries' REDD+ efforts"<sup>1</sup>, and that collaboration between UN-REDD and other REDD+ initiatives is on the agenda for discussion at the fourth Policy Board meeting, it is vital that the UN-REDD secretariat is able to continue to participate actively in these discussions.

The Policy Board full members are hereby requested to approve the following:

The Board agrees that given the role of the UN-REDD Programme Secretariat in managing partnerships and liaising with other REDD+ initiatives, the Secretariat is requested to work further with other REDD+ initiatives to explore options for strengthening cooperation and seeking coherence among them to support countries' REDD+ efforts. The Secretariat should present any findings to the Policy Board, as appropriate, and no later than at the 5<sup>th</sup> meeting.
