Common Approach

- Uses a performance-based approach to ensure Delivery Partners' social & environmental standards are "substantially equivalent"
 - Refers to material elements of applicable World Bank environmental and social safeguard policies and procedures; and
 - Compliance with FCPF requirements

WB Environmental and Social Safeguards Relevant to FCPF Readiness Fund

- 1. Environmental Assessment
- 2. Natural Habitats
- 3. Forests
- 4. Physical and Cultural Resources
- 5. Indigenous Peoples
- 6. Involuntary Resettlement

FCPF Requirements

- Strategic Environmental & Social Assessments (SESAs);
- FCPF/UN-REDD Guidelines on Stakeholder Engagement in REDD+ Readiness Preparation;
- Disclosure of Information; and
- Grievance & Accountability:
 - assistance to Pilot Country compliance with Guidelines for Establishing Grievance and Redress Mechanisms; and
 - DP accountability mechanism to respond/address claims related to the Common Approach
