REDD+ Hour: REDD+ and Biodiversity

30 November 15 :30 – 17 :30 EU Pavilion

This session will explore the latest developments with regards to REDD+ and biodiversity. Specific topics will include safeguards for biodiversity, tools for incorporating biodiversity conservation into REDD+, and monitoring of biodiversity as part of REDD+. Key developments from the COP10 CBD negotiations will be covered in a presentation by Tim Christophersen, Forest Programme Officer, CBD Secretariat. Barney Dickson, Head of Climate Change and Biodiversity, UNEP-WCMC will discuss the latest tools that have been developed for mapping and monitoring biodiversity in REDD+ pilot countries. Michael Bucki, DG Clima from the European Commission will present on European views on REDD-plus safeguards. A country representative (TBD) will provide the perspective of implementing REDD+ at the national level and the implications for biodiversity. Tim Kasten, Deputy Director of the Division for Environmental Policy, UNEP will moderate the event which will have ample time for questions, answers and discussions following the panelists' presentations.

Concept: Many developing country delegations have expressed a need for technical support on key issues such as REDD+ at international negotiations.
