Activities to be implemented under this request:

- Support the institutional and procedural arrangements between the agencies involved in REDD+;
- Ensure coordination between the different agencies involved in REDD+;
- Coordinate and organize all the regular meetings of REDD+ steering committee;
- Provide updated information on the progress of the REDD+ process;
- Assist and collect all different data and methodologies used for the development of the MRV system (forest inventory data, training manuals, the national database for tree species, forest cover analysis, national forest definition, forest stratification, allometric equations, volume tables etc.);
