With reference to your letter received on 23 January 2014, requesting targeted support from the UN-REDD Programme, I am pleased to inform you that the requested funding from the Government of Bhutan for further support to the National REDD+ strategy development, support to social and environmental safeguards and National Forest Monitoring System (NFMS) has been approved.

The UN-REDD Programme, through the three participating UN agencies, will support the proposal with a total amount of US\$ 245,000, which supplements the previous targeted support. As outlined in the proposal received, the funding will assist the development of Bhutan's National REDD+ Strategy to ensure safeguards including benefit distribution systems and anti-corruption measures, stakeholder engagement and support the development of the NFMS Action Plan and related capacity building.
