With reference to your letter received on 23 October 2013, requesting targeted support from the UN-REDD Programme, I have the honour to inform you that the requested funding for further stakeholder engagement in the REDD+ readiness process by the Government of Cambodia has been approved.

The UN-REDD Programme, through the United Nations Development Programme (UNDP) will financially support the proposal with a total amount of US\$10,000. It is supplementary funding to Cambodia's UN-REDD National Programme to support the strengthening of the Community Networks of Forestry, Protected Area and Fishery to participate fully and effectively in the REDD + efforts.
