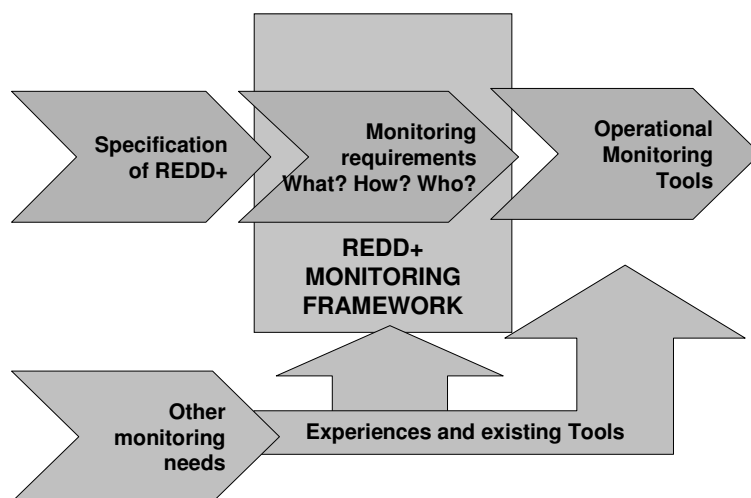

Monitoring requirements

1. Information categories:

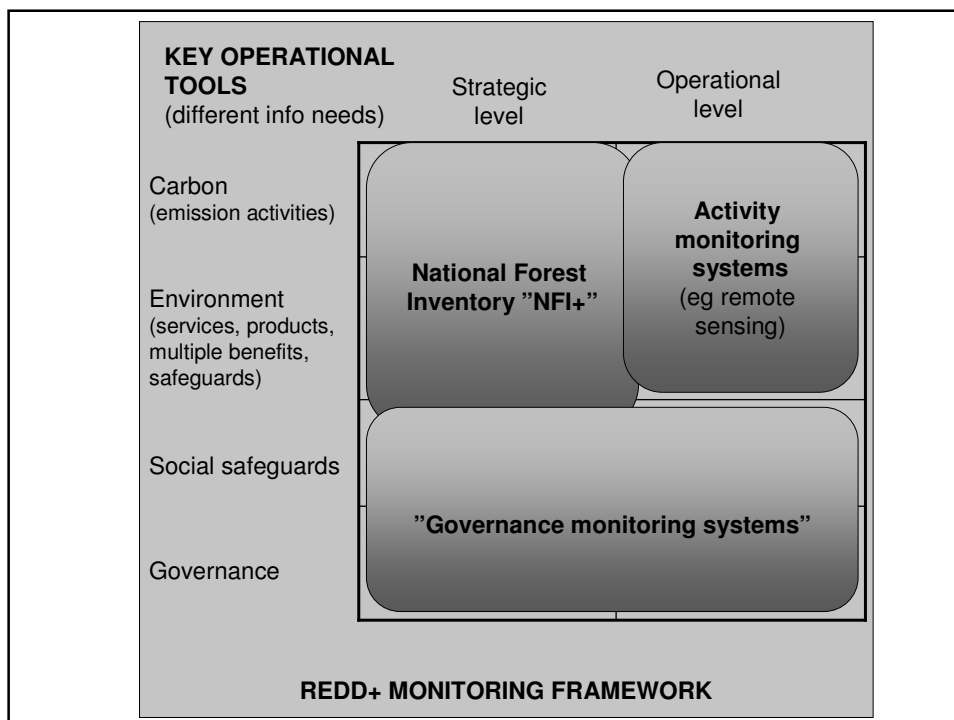
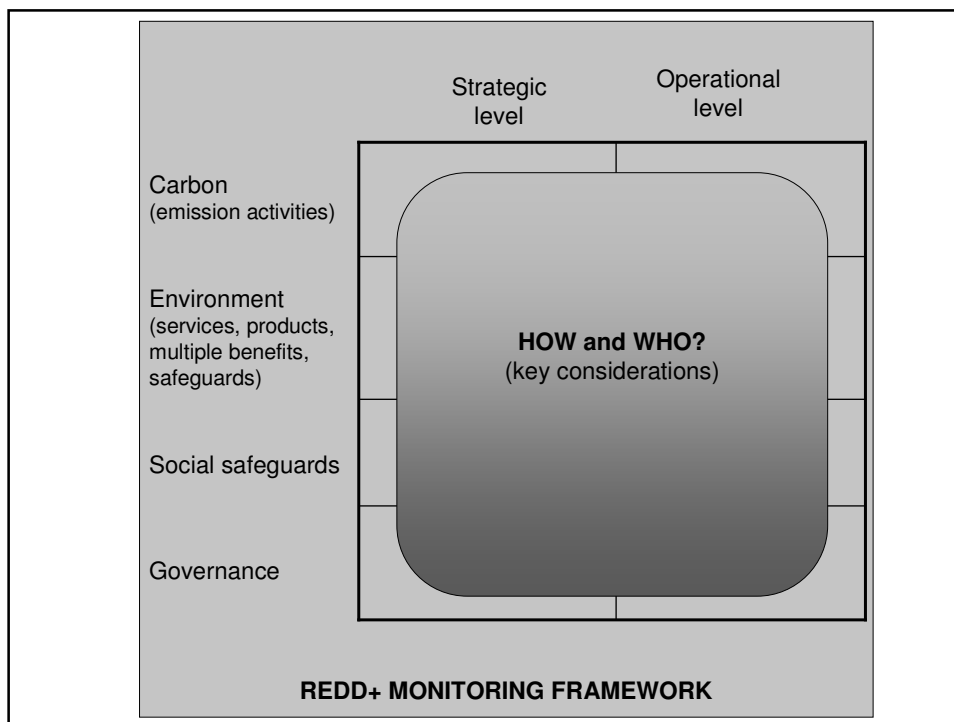
- Carbon
 - the results of emission activities
- Environment
 - the wider range of ecosystem services and products from forests (multiple benefits), including environmental safeguards
- Governance & Social Safeguards

Monitoring requirements

2. Levels and Purposes

- Strategic level
 - **Purpose:** Serve the needs of national policy processes and national level reporting requirements, including to comply with international commitments;
- Operational level
 - **Purpose:** Serve the needs of implementation on the ground, including assurances and enforcements at local / project / programme scale.

Carbon (emission activities)	GHG inventories	Activity data Mitigation proxies
Environment (services, products, multiple benefits, safeguards)	Biodiversity Wood and non-wood products Displacement	Land use Conservation Reversals
Social safeguards	Policy coherence with development goals	Livelihood impact
Governance	Regulatory framework Transparency/Accountability	Enforcement/Compliance Transparency/Accountability
