2. Levels and Purposes

- Strategic level
 - **Purpose:** Serve the needs of national policy processes and national level reporting requirements, including to comply with international commitments;
- Operational level
 - **Purpose:** Serve the needs of implementation on the ground, including assurances and enforcements at local / project / programme scale.
