REDD+ Partnership landscape

- REDD+ landscape is multifaceted and complex necessitating a range of partnerships:
 - Policy: REDD+ partnership
 - Capacity Building/Delivery: e.g. within the UN and between the UN and other multilaterals such as FCPF, FIP, GEF, CBFF, CBD, UNFCCC . Also working with Civil Society, IPs and research groups
 - Funding: contributing countries co-financing
- There will be many partnerships where the multilaterals are not involved

- Established in 2008 by FAO, UNDP & UNEP
 - Response to UNFCCC Bali Action Plan
- Always envisaged that it would work in partnerships
- Supports countries in their REDD+ efforts
 - Strong emphasis on capacity building
- Offers UN Joint Programming: Delivering as One UN
- Collaborates with FCPF, FIP and other institutions working on REDD+ activities
- Works closely with GEF, UNFCCC Secretariat and CBD



UN-REDD: Looking ahead

- Five Year Strategy Endorsed by Policy Board: This provides a shared vision for the 3 agencies to respond to country needs
 - Highlights imprtance of strategic partnerships
- Mobilizing adequate funding to support country capacities to prepare and implement REDD+ strategies
- A growing Programme: need to scale up in response to new demands
- Emphasis remains on coordinated action on the ground UN-REDD
